CAPTAIN ADAM FULLERTON COMPANY COMMANDER COMBAT LOGISTICS BATTALION 25

Captain Fullerton was born in Powder Springs, Georgia, on March 3, 1987. He enlisted in the Marine Corps in 2006 as a Military Police Officer, serving in MP Company, Headquarters Bn, 4th MARDIV. He served as a team leader, squad leader, and guide/platoon sergeant during his time here. In 2009 He attended Metropolitan State University of Minnesota and graduated in December of 2011 with a Bachelor of Arts Degree in Individualized Studies. He reached the rank of Sergeant in the Marine Corps Reserve before commissioning in August of 2012, completing his training at the Logistics Officer Course in December 2014. He then reported to Motor Transport Company, CLB 451, CLR 45 in Orlando, Florida, in December of 2014.

His first assignment was as third platoon commander. Captain Fullerton assisted with the planning and training of his platoon during Hydra-FEX 2015. During this time, he was also working towards his master's in government from Harvard University. Following the exercise, Captain Fullerton became the Operations Officer for the company. During this time he was accepted into the Education Studies (Concentration on Education Administration and Epistemology) Doctor of Philosophy Program at the University of Nebraska. As a civilian, he began working for the Marine Corps University instructing at the enlisted college as adjunct faculty in 2016.

In September of 2016, Captain Fullerton took the position of Executive Officer at Transportation Services Company, CLB 25, where he assisted in coordinating multiple sites and an OCONUS AT in Lativia for Operation Saber Strike. He assumed the role of Company Commander in August of 2017, immediately following the exercise. In May of 2018, Captain Fullerton dropped to the IRR to focus on completing his comprehensive doctoral examinations.

In October of 2018, Captain Fullerton returned to the SMCR, attaching to 3D Civil Affairs Group, obtaining the MOS of 0530. He served as an assistant team leader through an OCONUS AT to Japan before becoming a member of the G-9 Staff section for III MEF. It was at this time he also obtained the Information Operations Officer MOS 0510. As a civilian, Captain Fullerton successfully defended his dissertation in March of 2020, and was hired by the American College of Education.
