

## Sgt. Brittney St. Cere

## **Unites States Marine Corps**

On June 20th 1989, Brittney St. Cere was born in Charlotte, NC. Brittney attended Clemson University, where she majored in Elementary Education. She then began her teaching career with the Rock Hill School District 3, where she taught 3rd and 4th grade as well as being an academic interventionist.

In June 2013, Brittney St. Cere enlisted in the United States Marine Corps. Private First Class St. Cere completed recruit training at Marine Corps Recruit Depot Parris Island, SC in August 2013. Private First Class St. Cere then reported to Marine Combat Training at Camp Geiger, NC and then reported to Ground Supply School and graduated as the honor grad to obtain the MOS of 3043 as a supply administration and operations specialist. After completion, she was assigned to the Detachment 1 Supply Co CLB 451 in Greenville, SC as a reservist.

Brittney returned back to teaching as she continued her Marine Corps contract in the reserves. In December, 2014, Brittney then went on active duty orders in Quantico, VA, where she serve as a Funerals Honor clerk and was released from active duty in July 2015 and went back to teaching. In Mayv2018, Brittney attended the Combat Marksmanship course on Parris Island and earned the MOS of 0933 as a Combat Marksmanship Coach.

Throughout her career, she was meritoriously promoted to Corporal and Sergeant. In May 2016, Brittney graduated from the University of South Carolina with her master's degree in Educational Leadership and then was hired as the director of the Child Development Center on Parris Island in South Carolina.

In July 2020, Brittney was then hired as a Training and Curriculum Specialist at the Child Development Center on Camp Pendleton, CA, where she was responsible for the training and evaluation of personnel working as well as assisting with child development at the Child Development Center. In November 2021, Brittney St. Cere was then hired as the Deployment Readiness Coordinator for 2d Battalion, 1st Marines, as she serves as the direct link to Marines and their family members. She serves as the go to for communication, resources, and referral information, readiness and deployment, and volunteer management. She aids to ensure all Marines, Sailors, and their families are well informed and self-sufficient so that readiness at home translates to mission readiness for the Marines and Sailors.
