

Secretary/Deputy Executive Director: Tom Green, GySgt USMC (Ret.)

Tom served in the U.S. Marine Corps from 1967 - 1976. During this period he served in Vietnam in 1968, 1969, and 1970 with the 5th Marines.

Following his Active Duty service, he joined Co A, 1st Bn, 25th Marines in Manchester, NH. In 1979 he reenlisted in the Active Duty Marine Corps and retired from HQMC in 1989.

Personal decorations include the Joint Service Commendation, Navy Commendation, and Navy Achievement w/Combat "V." In addition he was nominated for Federal Employee of the Year in 1986.

In 1989 he became a full-time staff member/office manager of the former Marine Corps Reserve Officers' Association, now the Marine Corps Reserve Association. He served as the Association Deputy Director from 2002 until stepping down in 2004 to pursue other interests.

In June of 2007, he returned to MCRA as a volunteer in order to assist in the relocation of the national headquarters back to Fairfax and help in the revitalization efforts of the association. During this period he became the National Secretary and resumed his duties as the Deputy Executive Director and Legislative Representative to The Military Coalition and the Guard and Reserve Committee.
