HISTORY

Upon establishment in 1926, the Marine Corps Reserve Association (then known as the Marine Corps Reserve Officer Association) was the driving force behind numerous legislation improving the lives and operational preparedness of the Reserves. A notable achievement was the adoption of what is today Title X Sections 141 (c) and 5013(a) of the United States Code which guarantees a Corps of three division/wing teams and a seat on the Joint Chiefs of Staff for the Commandant for matters related to the Marine Corps. Today we remain dedicated to being at the forefront of legislative efforts for the Guard, Reserves and Veterans.


